

**2023/2024 DRAG RACING SEASON  
TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP POINT SCORE REGULATIONS**

**PHILOSOPHY:** The aim of the WA Drag Racing Championship is to encourage the maximum number of competitors at each event and give appropriate notoriety to our Champions.

**SUBSTITUTE DRIVERS:** Points will be awarded to a single driver only (no teams) unless specifically mentioned in a Brackets Advisory.

**BONUS POINTS:**

- a) The final National Open event for each Bracket will receive 50 percent (50%) bonus points.
- b) To receive bonus points for the above Final round, a competitor must attempt one qualifier by crossing the water under their own power.

**ELIGIBLE ROUNDS:**

- a) Super Comp Bracket will be calculated over all 6 Rounds scheduled.
- b) Top Comp will be calculated over a driver's best 8 results over the season.
- c) Summer Slam will be calculated over all 5 Rounds scheduled.
- d) Nitro Bike will be calculated over all 6 Rounds scheduled.
- e) All other Brackets all 9 Rounds will count towards the championship.

**NON-QUALIFIERS:** To receive the Non-Qualifier points minimum competitors must have attempted one qualifier by crossing the water under their own power.

**FIRST ROUND NO-SHOW:** If a competitor does not pass through the water box for the first round of eliminations, points will be allocated according the following:

- a) If a competitor fronts to the Staging Lanes for Round One and for any reason cannot start or move forward, they will be awarded first round lose points.
- b) If a competitor does not front to the staging lanes for Round One or withdraws from the event prior to eliminations that competitor will be awarded Non-Qualifier points.

**NO-SHOW AT ELIMINATION ROUNDS AFTER ROUND 1:** If a competitor has won an elimination round, they will receive lose points and prize money (if applicable) for the next round even if they are unable to front for that next round. Eg. If you win a round of racing, the worst you can possibly be is loser of the next round.

**ELIMINATION ROUND WIN:** A Competitor must stage under their own power to be considered a Winner of any Elimination Round

**POINT SCORE SUMMARY:** The point score summary will be posted on the Perth Motorplex web site within 2 days of the event.

**REGULATIONS:** Copies of the Perth Motorplex Track Championship Point Score Regulations (this document) are available from the Perth Motorplex web site in the Drag Racing Competitors Section.

**TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS:** A Bracket must contest at least 4 rounds in a season to award season Champions for that Bracket.

**TIE IN POINTS:** If two or more competitors in the same Bracket finish the season with the same number of points, the higher place in the Championship shall be awarded to, in order of:

- a) The competitor with the greatest number of wins.
- b) If the number of wins is the same, the holder of the greatest number of final round appearances.
- c) If the number of final round appearances is the same, the holder of the greatest number of semi-final round appearances.
- d) If the number of semi-final round appearances is the same, the holder of the greatest number of quarter-final round appearances and so on until the deadlock is broken.

**DRIVER/RIDER OF THE YEAR AWARDS:** *As there are an uneven number of eligible rounds for some brackets in the WA Drag Racing Championship Series, Driver of the year will be based on the percentage of points over the maximum available. i.e. If the maximum amount of points for the Bracket over the season is 900 points and a racer scores 750 points that racer will be on 83.3% in terms of the Driver/Rider of the Year*

**ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARDS:** A 'Rookie' is defined as a Racer in their first season of 'Full' senior competition. A Rookie who does not compete in more than 'Three' events in their first season is eligible for the Rookie awards in their second season. Rookie of the Year points will be counted over all 9 events of the Season.

**JUNIOR DRAGSTER:** Junior Dragster competitors are not eligible for Perth Motorplex Drag Racer of the Year or Rookie Racer of the Year awards. Junior Dragster competitors are considered 'Rookies' in their first year of 'full senior' competition.

**GARY MIOCEVICH AWARD OF EXCELLENCE:** The voting criteria will be on many aspects including but not limited to presentation, performance, sportsmanship, and general behaviour. The ballot forms will be kept private and confidential with our Events Administrator during the season. Depending on the closeness of the votes once tallied at the end of the season, the Top Five or nominees will be revealed prior to the Trophy Presentation evening. The nominees will each receive a Gary Mioceovich Award Nominee Plaque with the Winner receiving the Gary Mioceovich Award of Excellence Trophy.
