

2023/2024 SEASON SUPER COMP ADVISORY

1. ELIGIBLE CLASSES:

The Perth Motorplex Super Comp Eliminator is open to a selection of classes from the Competition, Super Stock Brackets. Vehicles must comply with relevant ANDRA class and safety regulations and may be subject to random classifying checks by ANDRA Stewards to confirm class legality at each event.

2. WA CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS FOR PERTH MOTORPLEX SUPER COMP BRACKET

Perth Motorplex Super Comp will run over six rounds for the 2023/2024 Season, 28th October 2023, 24-25th November 2023, 9th December 2023, 20th January 2024, 2-3rd March 2024 and 16th April 2024. All six rounds will count towards the 23/24 WA Super Comp Championship. (Note: Any racer wishing to run the events may do so in another suitable Bracket but no points will be awarded)

3. POINTS / PRIZEMONEY

4. RACING FORMAT

Super Comp will run the Chicago Shootout Style Format regardless of field size. Chicago Shootout Regulations can be found on the website - http://www.motorplex.com.au/drag-competitors/ Except for the Goldenstates and Westernationals, when ANDRA Elimination Format will be run.

5. HANDICAPPING:

Perth Motorplex Super Comp will use the ANDRA Class Handicap system for the 2023/2024 season. For details see *Page 20 of the 2023/2024 ANDRA Rule Book*.

6. CLASS SWAPPING:

Under the ANDRA Class Handicap System there are no penalties for Class swapping.

7. SUPER COMP ALTERNATE BRACKETS

Perth Motorplex Super Comp competitors who race in an alternative elimination bracket during the season at the ANDRA Summit Sportsman rounds ONLY, in Competition Eliminator or Super Stock, the points from these alternate brackets will be allocated towards Super Comp in the WA Drag Racing Championship Series.

8. SUBSTITUTE DRIVERS

A competitor can substitute a driver however points can only be allocated to individual drivers.
