OH WHAT A FEELING!

Here we go again!

If the start to the season was any kind of indication, we are in for a treat in the 2025-26 Maddington Toyota Sprintcar Series Championship.

History shows that former series champion Callum Williamson took the win in the opening bout, the City of Kwinana Powerpalooza.

It took some time for the Geraldton throttle stomper to find his groove in the new-look W3, being third quickest in his qualifying group, then taking a second in his heat race and racing up to a fourth in the A Dash, setting him up for a p7 start in the feature race.

The feature was a drawn-out affair that forced officials to call a fuel stop, given the high number of rolling laps.

Williamson's win showed he was once again going to be a force this summer.

The show also revealed plenty of other drivers were also ready to push hard.

Taylor Milling took second in what was a massive turnaround for the Kalgoorlie-based driver.

The last time he raced at the Motorplex, back in the grand final in March, he crashed hard, suffering a major neck injury.

Extensive rest and rehab in the off-season paid off as Milling, in a new W25, took second after starting from p10.

He will also be one to watch, as will Daniel Harding who started the feature race from p7 – again showing plenty of pace in the Trevor Jolly Racing W18.

Brad Maiolo, another two-time series champion, was fourth, setting himself up for a big season ahead.

With LJM Racing currently only running one car (with older brother Jamie unable to race due to a major back injury last season), and a new crew chief for the season, Brad looks strong after starting from the fifth row.

Defending and two-time series champion Dayne Kingshott started from p2 and after early contact with Kris Coyle, who started from p3, he was relegated back to p16.

The Krikke Motorsport W2 pilot raced hard to get back up to fifth, a gain of 11 points and in the process, he won the Kinrome Hard Charger award for the round.

Jason Kendrick appears to have turned the corner after a couple of lean seasons.

The former three-time series champion fronted with a new car and an impressive new white and gold livery, and a sixth placed finish gives the Kendrick Racing W11 team something to work on for this weekend's show.

James Inglis, another former series champion, also looked competitive in a new car, complete with a new look and a new number.

He started from p16 and finished seventh, a good result, and like Kendrick, the team has something to build on.

Another hard charger was last season's Rookie of the Year, Michael Keen, in the Cowara Motorsport W41.

Keen started the race from p17 and moved up to eighth, settling back into the groove quickly after missing the mark in qualifying.

A notable performance came from Coyle who was second in the A Dash and looking for a big finish until contact with Jy Corbett in the Monte Motorsport entry, which put both of them out.

Expect both to be knocking on the door for top five results.

Aaron Chircop showed he has plenty of pace when he had a heat win and was second in the Revolution Racegear B Dash – now he has to build on that after being one of the many DNFs in the first outing.

Young gun Jack Williamson was in the wars on the night, right from hot laps through to the feature race and ultimately a DNF in the final summed up their night.



If he can get things sorted and get some luck, he will well and truly be in the show.

It is good to see some of the newcomers to the series find their feet when thrown in the deep end and we can't wait to see the development curve for drivers such as Chad Pittard, Kodi Clayden, Joe Latham, Mike Green, Harrison Peet and others.

The future of the series here in WA is in good hands, with so many new teams entering the fray.

And tonight we welcome a few more drivers to the list who missed the opening round.

Good luck to all competitors in the Electrical Group Training Westernapolis.

We will see you back here again in a couple of weeks for round three.

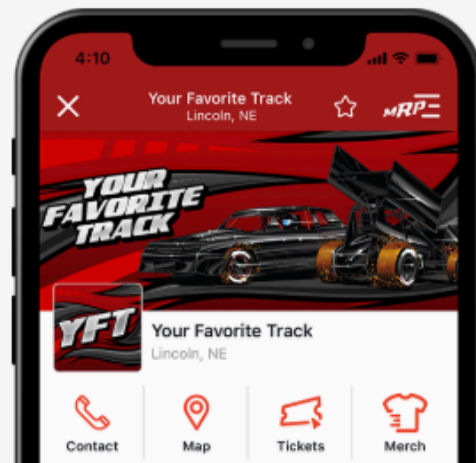

Who Will Claim Round Three?

The stars of the Pro Dirt Series are ready to light up the Perth Motorplex once again this weekend, with Round Three of the 2025/26 championship, proudly presented by the team at ABN Trade Mates, shaping up as another blockbuster on the Late Model Racing WA calendar.

After two thrilling rounds to open the season, the points battle is already fierce and with the current leader Jamie Oldfield not in this weekend's field, it gives a whole host of drivers the chance to finish the round atop the points.

This will be the third round for the season and the three hundred and fifth round ever, with plenty of drivers wanting to claim their part of that history tonight.

Fresh off his impressive victory at the last Motorplex round, Warren Oldfield will be one of the favourites again as he looks to make it back-to-back wins and build early-season momentum. His experience around the Perth venue always makes him a major contender.

Joe Chalmers, who has been one of the standout performers so far this season, is in the hot seat coming into this round. With a second and a third from the opening two rounds, he sits second in the overall standings and looks primed to challenge for his first feature race win of the year.

Right behind him in the points is Brent Vosbergen, who continues to show his trademark consistency with a fifth and a fourth-place finish. Vosbergen has been right in the mix each time out and will be aiming to climb onto the podium this weekend.

Rookie sensation Beau Oldfield has turned heads in his debut Pro Dirt campaign, sitting seventh in the championship thanks to a pair of solid performances. With every lap behind the wheel, Beau continues to gain confidence and could well break into the top five this round.

Among those looking to bounce back after mixed results are Brad Blake, who has a seventh-place finish and a DNF so far, and Greg Horan, who will be hoping for a change of luck after a DNF and 13th-place result to start his season.

Ken Macpherson will also be eager to rebound after his podium finish at the season opener was followed by a DNF at the last show.

Peter Walker will be another one to watch after storming through the field as the hard charger last time out, while David Nylander and Luke Halliday have quietly built consistent form, both recording strong top-ten results across the opening two rounds.

Further down the order, Michael Holmes has improved with each outing, while David Boyes, Nathan Richards, and Chris Barrow will all be pushing hard to move forward after some early-season challenges.

Abbey Pickering will be looking for a smooth run after recording a DNF and an 11th to start her season, while Veronica McCann makes her much-anticipated return after injury forced her out of the last round, determined to bounce back from a DNF in the opener.

Jay Cardy has been steady inside the top ten with two strong results, while Jay Bassinelli will be aiming to improve on his 13th-place finish from the season opener.

Ryan Huxtable will be looking to recover from a tough outing last round, and Mat Robbins is set to make his first Pro Dirt appearance of the season, adding even more depth to an already competitive field.

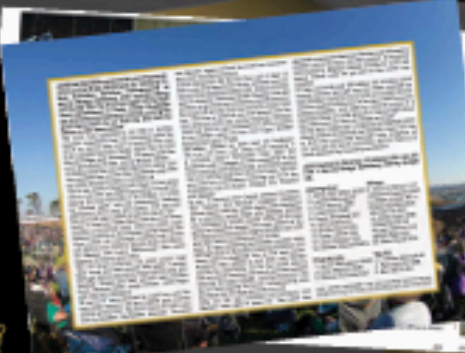
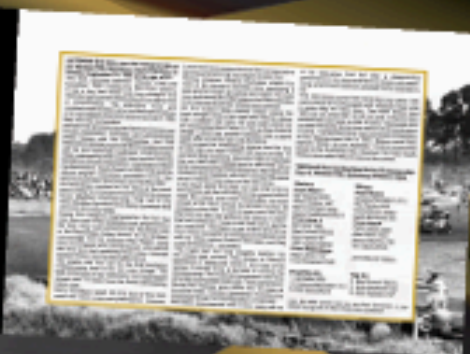

A Time Honoured Event!

The time-honoured WA Speedcar Championship returns here to the Perth Motorplex tonight, with a quality field of drivers ready to battle for one of Western Australia's most prestigious motorsport titles.

Defending champion Harry Stewart (aboard the Graham Jones Racing #4) will be out to make history as he aims to go back-to-back in the 78th running of the event. Remarkably, Stewart is also the only former WA Champion in this year's field – a fact that adds even more weight to his title defence.

Fresh off a dominant win at the most recent Motorplex meeting, Kaidon Brown brings hot form into the championship. The interstate star is no stranger to success in the big race, having already finished on the WA Championship podium in seasons past and he would love to put the Travis White Racing #38 machine back there this weekend.

He'll be joined by a host of drivers with proven records in this event, including Alfie Guadagnino, Patrick Watson, Beau Doyle, and Vaughan Manders, who have each stood on the podium in previous editions.

Another driver who could easily steal the spotlight is Keenan Fleming, who has twice finished runner-up in the WA Championship and will be hungry to go one better this weekend. Fleming's recent second-place finish behind

Brown shows he's right in the mix for the crown.

Local charger Jake Robinson will look to continue his strong recent form after finishing third last start, while Nicholas Rowe, a podium finisher in last year's championship, will be eager to bounce back after mechanical dramas last round.

Consistent performers Rob Golding, William Douglas, Cory Smith, and Chris Dymock are also expected to be right in contention when the green flag drops.

With a field stacked with experience, form, and ambition, this year's Total Tools Rockingham WA Speedcar Championship promises to deliver one of the most competitive editions yet.

First run in 1946, the WA Speedcar Championship remains one of the sport's most historic and sought-after trophies, and this Saturday night, another name will be etched into its legendary honour roll.

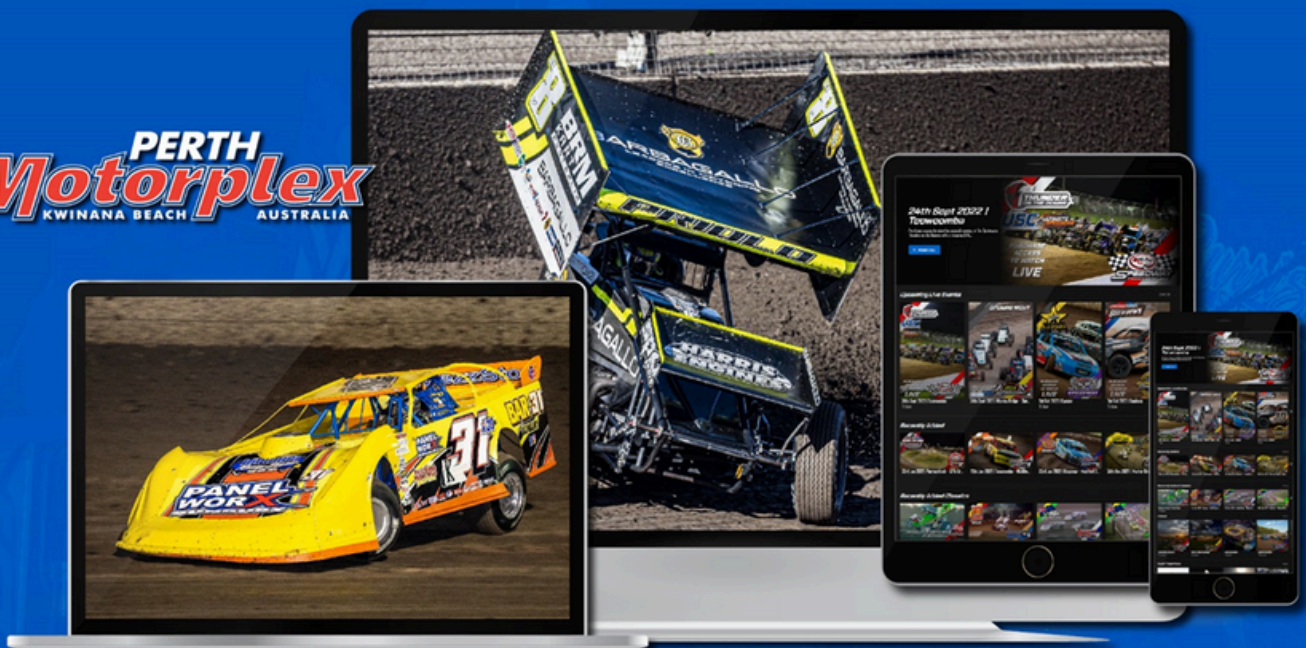

The Wily Veteran - Vaughan Manders

There is no driver in tonight's field for the 78th running of the Total Tools Rockingham WA Speedcar Championship that has more laps around a speedway track and years of racing experience than Vaughan Manders.

While these days he is probably more well-known for being the father of the Speedcar (and now) Sprintcar star Kaiden Manders, Vaughan has had a Speedway career that has spanned well over four decades and is well and truly worthy of recognition in his own right.

Vaughan began his Speedway career in 1978, racing B-grade (and soon after A-Grade) Saloons (as sedans were known as in those days) at the now defunct Bibra Lake Speedway.

In the 47 years since, Manders has been what you can call a journeyman driver, having tried his hand at many different Speedway divisions over his time in the sport.

He has driven everything from Super Sedans, Super 6 Sedans, Modified Sedans, Production Sedans and has even tried his hand at V8 Non-wing and LS1 Sprintcars in the recent past.

However it's in the Wild 'n' Wingless Speedcar brigade that Vaughan has truly found himself at home, having raced Speedcars off and on over the past twenty-one seasons.

Manders is a prime example of a budget racer.

He's never really had the best or latest equipment, nor has he had a career littered with a ton of accolades and trophies, but armed with some good old-fashioned make-do and know-how, he's been able to get some strong results over the years.

Vaughan has had a few career highlights, most notably finishing 3rd in the 2011/12 running of the WA Speedcar Championship behind Scott Glazebrook and the winner that season David Ellement.

He has also been awarded several club awards from the West Australian Speedcar Drivers Association (WASDA) over the years, including the Stan Kinloch Fairest and Best award for division 2 drivers on two occasions (2010/11 and 2004/05 seasons) the Doc Parton Encouragement Award (2010/11) and the Poppa Lynch Most Improved Driver Award (2011/12).

In addition, Vaughan also has two Claremont Speedway track records to his name, owning the track records for Modified Sedans over 12 and 8 lap distances, an honour nobody can take away.

Vaughan also has another distinct, if not obscure honour to his name.

To the best of our knowledge, Vaughan Manders is the last former member of the Waroona Speedway Club that is still actively racing, a club which ceased to exist in 1988.

That's a badge of honour all of its own.

Vaughan has been a valiant and dedicated competitor for many years, and while he has no desire to call time on his career just yet, I wanted put the spotlight on one of our sports "unsung heroes"

A podium or top five in tonight's State Championship would be just about as good as a win for Vaughan, but everyone knows, anything can happen in Speedway.

So if you want an underdog driver to cheer for in the Speedcars tonight, keep your eyes peeled on the red Manders Automotive #57.

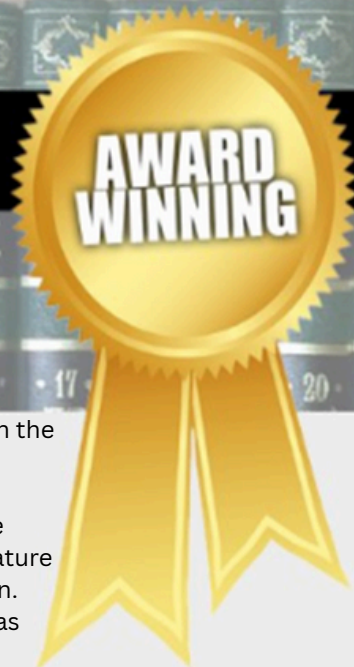

Powerpalooza was a great way to kick off the season, but interestingly, all four feature winners on the night had already claimed a feature win previously.

Warren Oldfield won his second Powerpalooza event (though his first on the opening night of the season) and it was his twenty eight career Motorplex victory (and thirty fourth Pro Dirt Series feature win). Kaidon Brown has now won three features here in Speedcars, two of which came last season. Cody Turacchio had never won a Motorplex feature until the 10th of February 2024 but he now has seven career Motorplex victories, while Callum Williamsons victory was the third time he has claimed the season opener and his twenty first career Motorplex win.

Tonight we celebrate the Westernapolis event, which has had a chequered history since first being held in the 1980/81 season at Claremont Speedway. Ray Geneve won that event, with Bill Sutherland claiming the victory in the next season. Martin Laughton would win in the 1982/83 season, with Sutherland again winning the next two, while Ron Krikke claimed the sixth annual race a year later.

Though the research continues, it appears the event went on hiatus until 1997/98 when Pino Priolo claimed the win. The event would again reappear in 2000/01 when the Motorplex opened, American Donny Schatz claiming the win. Luch Monte won the event in 2003/04 before the event went on another break, finally reappearing in 2013/14 for another three seasons. These victories were shared by Shaun Bradford, David Priolo and James McFadden. Westernapolis reappeared in 2019/20, with Jock Goodyer claiming the win, before another hiatus the next year. In 2021/22 the event appeared once again and has been held ever since, Jason Kendrick, Dayne Kingshott and James Inglis claiming the next few wins, while last season Dayne Kingshott claimed his second win in the event. Who will add their name to this list this weekend?

Ok, so last week didn't quite pan out, but... stay tuned to the big screen tonight... the stats are going wild!

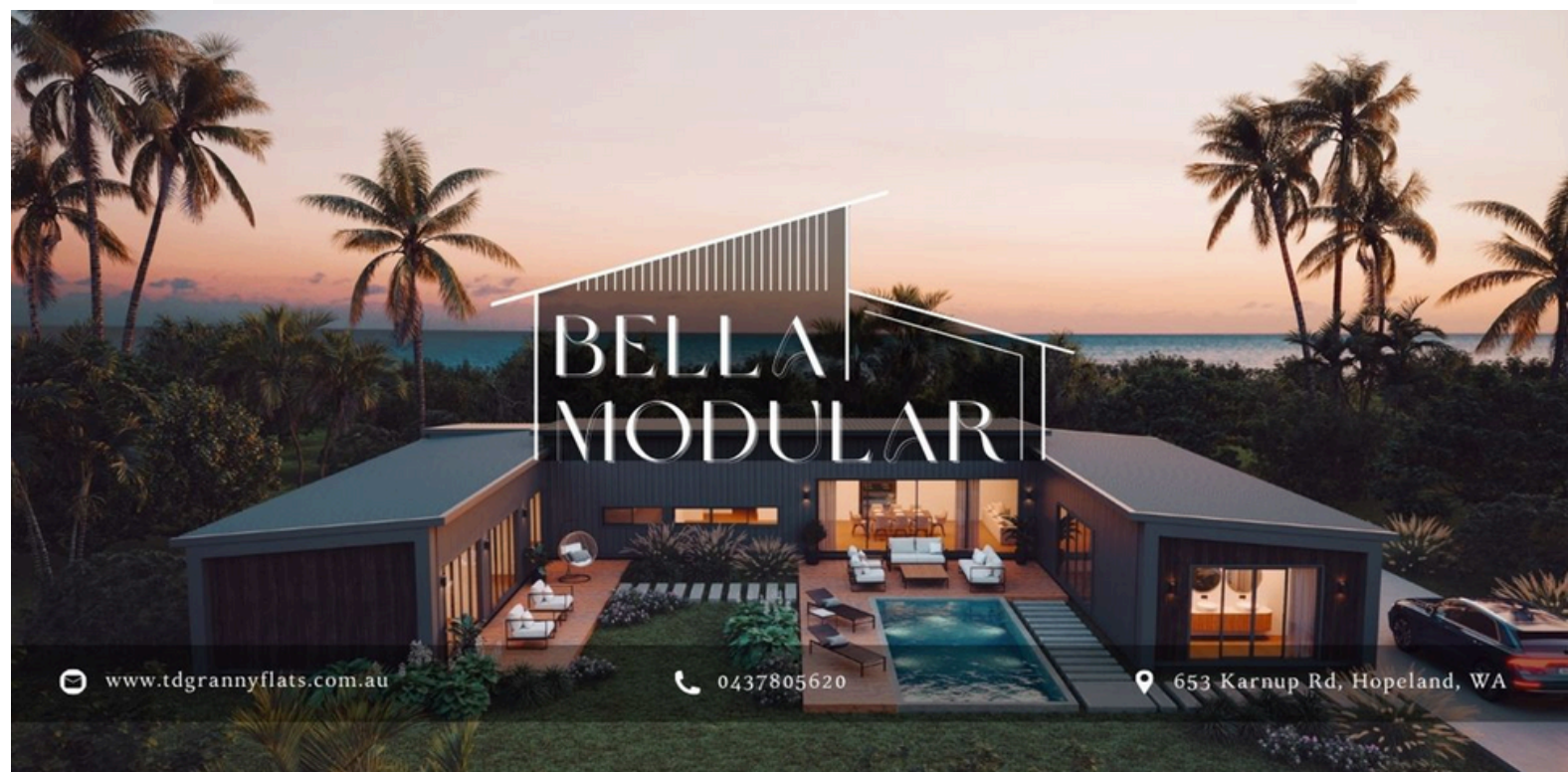
