



The Festival of Sprintcars has three nights in the books, with the Barbagallo Australian Mr Sprintcar Nationals last Friday and Saturday nights, followed by the Performance Racegear Midweek Mayhem on Wednesday night.

Now it is time for the final two shows of the festival – the Total Tools Rockingham Krikke Boys Shootout.

This event is one that is close to the hearts of many people involved in speedway – and none more so than the Krikke family.

It's a weekend where 'for the boys' and the number '95' take on extra special meaning.

Much has been documented about why we have this event and no doubt over the course of the weekend that story will be told again, so I will leave that to others to tell.

As for the racing, well that continues to deliver.

We continue to see drivers and crews pushing themselves to the limit.

We continue to see drama.

We continue to see favourites not go the journey – even when they are in race-winning positions.

And we continue to be amazed at the spectacle that is Sprintcar racing.

It's a brutal game and one where predictability goes out the window.

And that's why I tell people, if racing a Sprintcar was so easy, then we would see more people doing it.

If you commit to racing one of these beasts, you have my admiration.

There is no other form of motorsport like it, and it is great to see such strong numbers in the Maddington Toyota Sprintcar Series.

This weekend marks rounds 16 and 17 of the series that goes over 23 rounds and will wrap up with the grand final on Saturday, March 28.

Thank you must go to the huge number of visiting teams, from both the eastern states, as well as from America who have committed to many of the rounds.

This is the last weekend we will see Americans Justin Whittall and Aaron Reutzel, along with America-based Kerry Madsen, before they head back to the US to start their big seasons ahead.

Reutzel has claimed two feature wins here in WA so far, along with victory in the Classic at Warrnambool.

A win here this weekend will be another reward for the effort put in by Monte Motorsport.

Whittall has continued to look strong in a big campaign in the RBH Racing U21, but missed out on some of the results that were probably coming his way.

It would be great if this likeable throttle stomper could finish on a high this weekend.

Madsen was looking good in the feature race here on Wednesday night before he pushed the limits a little too hard on a challenging track and ended up watching the race unfold from the infield.

He set the pace at the start of the show by setting Quick Time, showing there is still plenty of life left yet when it comes to the Mad Man.

Callum Williamson was caught up in Madsen's crash and despite a badly-damaged front wing, he was able to resume the battle and cross the line second behind Reutzel.

Defending series champion Dayne Kingshott claimed yet another podium, showing why he is one of the form drivers in the country.

Well done to popular South Aussie Matt Egel on his fourth, and to Queenslander Ryan Newton who rounded out the show in fifth.



They were followed over the finish line by Lachlan McHugh, Whittall, Jack Williamson, Randy Morgan, Kaiden Manders, Daniel Harding, Jock Goodyer, Marcus Dumesny, Jye McKenzie, Luke Oldfield, Kris Coyle, Mick Saller, Andrew Priolo and Ryan Lancaster.

One of the notable absences from the results sheet was former Australian champion James McFadden who won both races last weekend but had major mechanical issues and failed to fire a shot.

The Team Brady W23 packed up early to get the car sorted for this weekend.

Fans of supercars will be keen to see how former WA lad Brodie Kosteki goes over the next two nights.

He raced last Friday and Wednesday nights as he gets more comfortable in a Sprintcar, while also focusing on the Supercar championship that will start very soon.

Good luck to all teams tonight.

Our next rounds will be in Geraldton on Saturday, February 28 and Sunday, March 1.

We look forward to seeing a lot of racefans at the Mid-West venue.

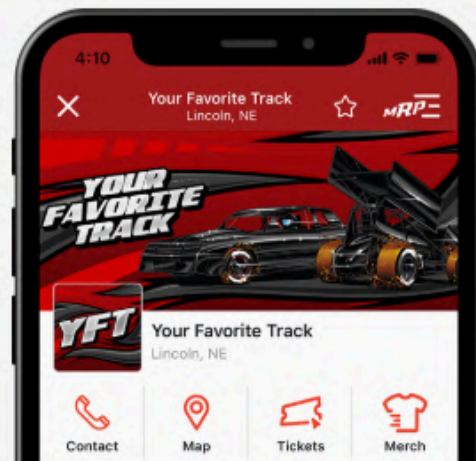

Johnny: a true champion

Over the past few years much has been made of the Johnny Andersson Classic.

Now into its fifth year, the event has been a popular addition to the Formula 500 calendar, not just because it has been a solid race meeting, but because it pays tribute to one of the all-time greats of TQ/Formula 500 racing.

Johnny's on track exploits are well known; summed up as a long-time competitor with plenty of success including three Australian Titles and six WA Titles. But it is more than that.

Yes, he had over fifty years of competition and was inducted into the Speedway Australia Hall of Fame in 2016 as the first West Australian to win an Australian title in any car division, claiming the

1973/74, 1974/75 and 1976/77 Formula 500 (TQ) Championships.

Yes, the first of his WA Title wins was in 1967/68 and his last in the 1979/80 season. This on top of three second places and five third places over an even larger period, gave him fourteen podiums across thirty-one years.

Yes, Johnny is one of the all-time greats at Claremont Speedway, grabbing sixty-seven feature races at the venue between 1958 and 1994, more than double the next best of 31.

Yes, he was a Championship racer, with a Perth Motorplex Track Championship to his name at the ripe age of 63.

But off-track Johnny is just as well known.

Back in his heyday, Johnny was still working hard behind the scenes, often seen wandering around helping others a majority of the time for little or no charge.

He always tried to keep guys out there racing for the good of the division, rather than looking at what was best for himself.

He builds engines, successful ones.

Assisted travelling racers.

Even worked on the grader at tracks like Bibra Lake.

He is a long-time club person for both Formula 500's WA and other associations, the role of scrutineer one he still plays today. The go to man for technical advice, scrutineering and a stalwart of the division.

So yes, his on-track achievements made him Hall of Fame worthy.

But his efforts off track make him a legend of a man.

A gentleman.

And that is why, for the fourth time, we honour him this weekend with the Johnny Andersson Classic.

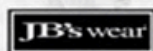

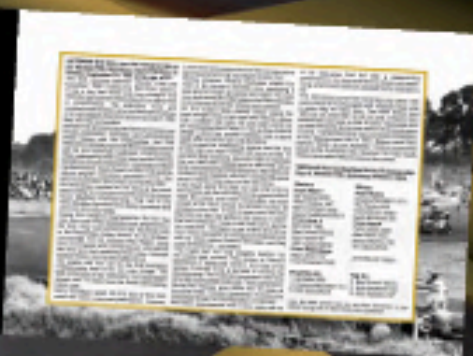

Ready to Shine!

The LS1 Sprintcars are set to play a thrilling supporting role at this weekend's Total Tools Rockingham Krikke Boys Shootout at the Perth Motorplex, and with Track Championship implications on the line, there's plenty at stake.

Heading into the weekend, Jeremy Hale holds a 53-point advantage at the top of the LS1 Track Championship standings over defending Krikke Boys winner Troy Beckingham.

However, at time of writing Hale was not nominated for tonight's event, potentially throwing the championship fight wide open and placing Beckingham firmly in the box seat to capitalise.

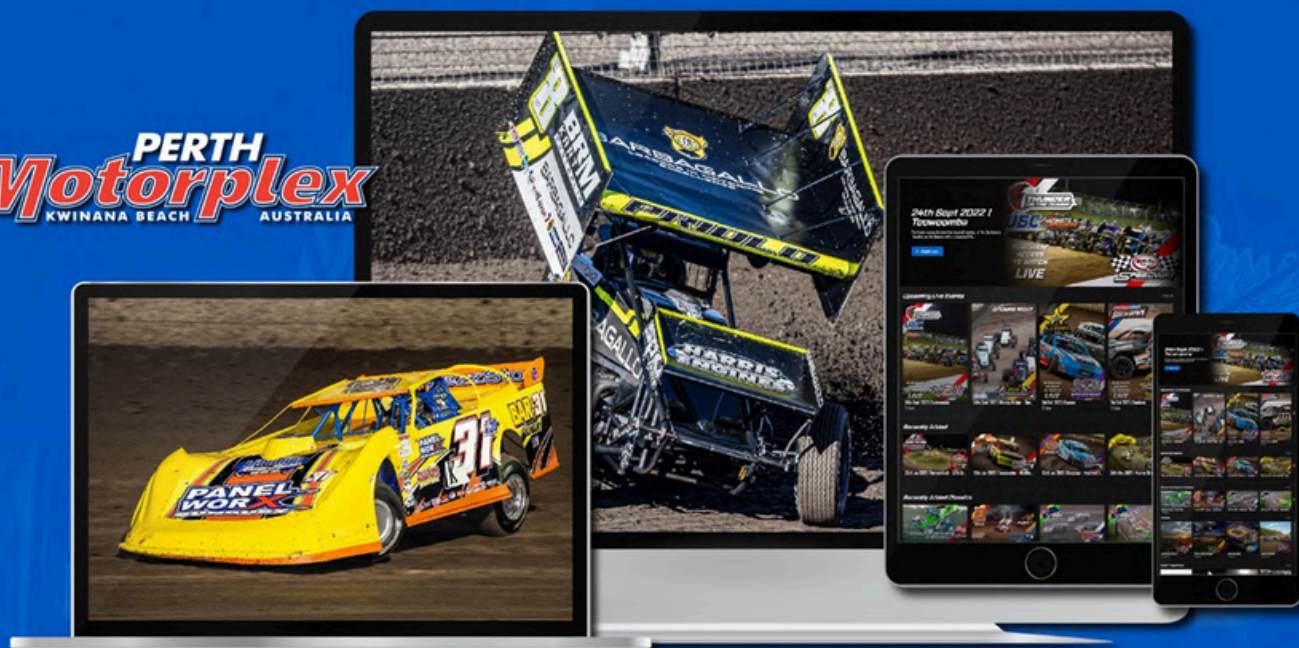

Ten Rounds in: Action Aplenty!

The Late Models roar back into action tonight at the Perth Motorplex as part of the annual Krikke Boys Shootout for Round Ten of the 2025/2026 Pro Dirt Series, proudly supported by Ross's Auctioneers and Valuers.

After more than a month away from racing, the divisions last appearance coming at Bunbury on January 13, the thunder and lightning Late Models are set for a highly anticipated return, and with the championship battle tightening, every lap will count.

Heading into Round Ten, Joe Chalmers leads the Pro Dirt Series standings, holding a narrow but crucial advantage over Beau Oldfield, Michael Holmes, and Jay Cardy. Interestingly, the top four in the series are mirrored exactly in the Perth Motorplex Track Championship standings, setting the stage for a pivotal night in both title chases.

While Chalmers sits atop the leaderboard, victory has eluded him so far this season. The consistency has been remarkable, six podium finishes without a win, but the breakthrough feature triumph remains just out of reach. If he can convert pace into victory lane this weekend, it could prove a defining moment in his 2025/26 season campaign.

Beau Oldfield and Michael Holmes have also shown strong form, each recording three podium finishes without yet claiming a feature win. Oldfield, in particular, will be looking to bounce back after his strong recent Motorplex showing where he stood on the podium behind feature winner Kye Blight, who is not in the field this weekend.



The most recent round in Bunbury delivered a memorable family result, with Warren Oldfield defeating brother Jamie Oldfield and nephew Beau Oldfield in a special Oldfield family trifecta. Jamie is not nominated for this weekend's event either, while Warren returns as the only driver in Saturday night's field to have won a feature race this season, a stat that places him squarely in the spotlight.

A quality field has been assembled for Round Ten, including the return of rookie Jorj Park aboard the #77 machine. Park continues to gain valuable experience in his debut season and will be eager to make his mark against some of the state's best.

Veronica McCann is also back in action and shaping as a genuine contender if momentum goes her way. Meanwhile, series regulars such as Rod Musarra, Luke Halliday and Abbey Pickering will be looking to put together strong performances as they chase valuable championship points and a potential breakthrough result in preparation for the five nights of fury coming up next month.

With ten rounds into the series and the margins tightening at the top, the pressure is rising. The absence of recent feature winners like Kye Blight and Jamie Oldfield opens the door for a new name to step forward, or for one of the championship contenders to finally convert consistency into victory.

Round Ten of the Pro Dirt Series promises intensity, strategy and high-speed drama as the Late Models return to the Perth Motorplex spotlight.

The title race is on, and tonight could be a turning point.

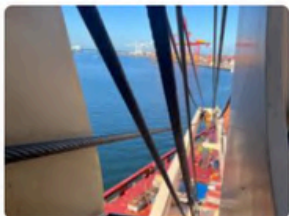

Limited Sprintcars Set for Krikke Boys Shootout Showdown

The Limited Sprintcars return to the Perth Motorplex tonight as part of the Total Tools Rockingham Krikke Boys Shootout, and with championship points on the line, the action is set to be intense.

Saturday's program doubles as Round 10 of the 2025/26 Keenquip Championship, as well as Round 4 of the Perth Motorplex Track Championship, giving teams plenty to race for as the season begins to build toward its business end.

At the top of the Keenquip Championship standings sits Joel Ettridge, who holds the advantage over Glenn Dickinson and Anthony Gaudio.

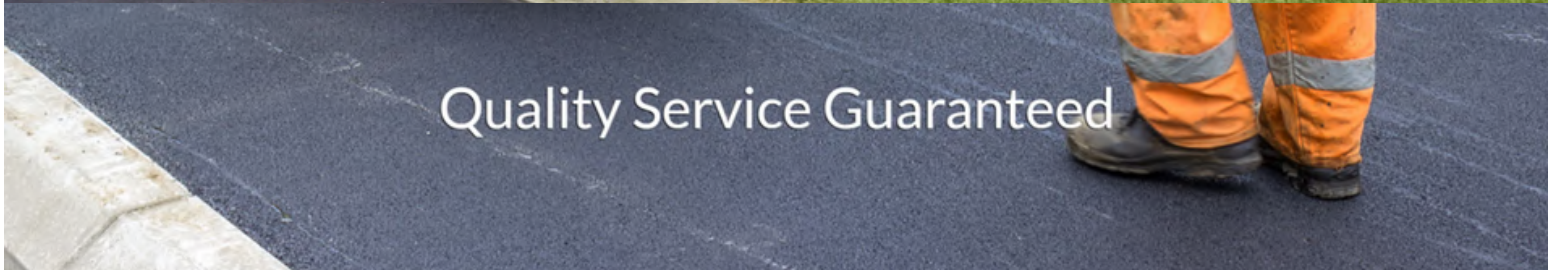

70 years of the Amazing Anderssons- The Andersson Family Legacy

Tonight, the Formula 500 brigade will be honouring one of the all-time greats of Australian Speedway with the running of Johnny Andersson Classic.

Beginning in 1956 and finishing in 2006, John Andersson had one of the longest running and most decorated careers in Australian Speedway history.

Inducted into Australian Speedway Hall of Fame in 2016, Johnny Andersson was the very first West Australian Speedway competitor to win an Australian championship in any car division, winning his first of 3 career national titles at Claremont Speedway in 1974.

Andersson would go back-to-back, winning his second Australian Championship at Bundaberg, Queensland's Carina Speedway in 1975 before winning the final of his national titles at Murray Bridge Speedway in South Australia in 1977.

His successes in National championships weren't just limited to wins, with Johnny also holding the record for the most podium placings of any driver in the history of the Australian TQ/ Formula Championship, having also finished second 3 times and third on 5 occasions over the course of his career.

Back at home, away from the national spotlight, Andersson amassed a level of success that is almost beyond belief for those of us that weren't there to witness it.

Johnny would win six West Australian Championships throughout his career, finishing on the podium in that event on a further eight occasions (three second placings and five thirds).

Johnny Andersson was a master of the big Claremont circuit, winning 67 feature races at Claremont Speedway in the time period spanning from 1958 until 1994.

That tally of 67 wins is more than double that of the next best TQ/ Formula competitors at with Des Ferris and Billy Broadwood tied for second in the record books on 31 wins apiece.

For his contribution to West Australian Speedway history, Johnny was inducted into the Claremont Speedway Hall of Fame during Claremont's last season.

The thing that stands out the most about Johnny Andersson's career isn't just amount of race wins, it's the consistency and longevity he displayed over the decades.

Even in the later part of his career, Johnny never lost his competitive edge.

In 2003 (his 47th year in racing) Andersson would win the Perth Motorplex Formula 500 Track Championship, at 63 years of age!

Off the racetrack, Johnny has served in many executive positions on the Formula 500 Association of WA committee over the years and has also served as a scrutineer for the WA Formula 500 Association.



Johnny's son Shane (pictured above in his first drive in 1990 at the age of 14 in a Bryan Mullings car) followed in his father's footsteps and has had a long and successful career of his own, racing for the last 35 years!

And while it must be said that he hasn't won as many races or titles as his dad has, Shane has still had his fair share of highlights over the years.

This included one of the feel-good moments of last season, when Shane claimed victory the Formula 500 King of wings, 16 years, 8 months and 17 days after his last race win at the Motorplex.

If he's able to take the win tonight, it would most certainly be another special occasion.

For a family to be involved in speedway for 7 decades (especially on the level they have!) speaks volumes of the amount of passion, dedication and love that they have for our sport.

Those are three things that the Andersson Family have in spades and I wish them all the best tonight in as we honour a legend of our sport!

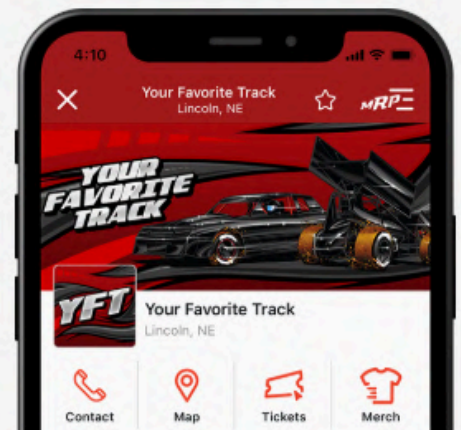

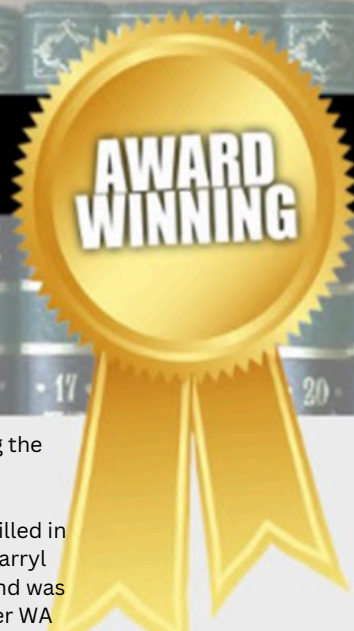

This weekend will see the 29th annual Krikke Boys Shootout held right here at the Perth Motorplex, marking the fourth time the Motorplex has held it.

Back on Saturday the 8th of March, 1997, promising young talents Darryl and Jason Krikke were tragically killed in a road accident on their way home from testing their Sprintcar at the Claremont Speedway. Aged just 21, Darryl was the son of two-time Australian Sprintcar Champion Ron Krikke and had been running well here in WA and was just starting to make a name for himself in appearances over East. Jason, aged just 18, was the son of former WA Sprintcar Champion John Krikke, and was on a meteoric rise alongside his cousin as the one behind the scenes turning the spanners. Just 25km from their home base of Bunbury, their car left the road and hit a tree, leaving the local Speedway devastated. From the ultimate sadness was born the ultimate Sprintcar event: a true party where a Sprintcar race broke out scenarios, many teams making the trek across from the East to Bunbury every year, such is the prestige.

Although a tribute was held at Claremont Speedway in the weeks after their death in conjunction with the King of Wings event, the first official Krikke Boys shootout was held in the 1997/98 season, won by the late great Michael Figliomeni. In the years that followed Robbie Farr would amass a record seven wins in the event, while Victorian Max Dumesny, who was a close family friend and made the trip over every year, claimed the win three times. Figs would claim another event while others including Terry Cutts, the late American Jason Johnson, fellow countrymen Shane Stewart and Tim Kaeding, plus Kerry Madsen would all add their names to the winners list in the late 2000's and into the 2010's.

Brooke Tatnell finally won the race in the 2014/15 season while Steven Lines won the event the year after. In 2016/17 the race took on a new meaning when Shane Krikke, long time racer and team owner of Krikke Motorsport, passed away on June 26th, 2016 after a long battle with cancer. James McFadden would win that year, the first of his three victories which would come in 2019 and 2020: Jamie Veal interrupting McFadden's streak when he claimed victory in 2018.

The race first headed to the Motorplex in 2021 (where Farr claimed his seventh win) before returning to Bunbury in 2022 where local driver Kris Coyle stunned the racing world to take the win, the first local driver in twenty years to achieve the feat. The Krikke Boys Shootout then came back to the Motorplex the following year, where it has been held, with the blessing and support of Ron and John Krikke, ever since. Queenslander Lachlan McHugh won in 2023 while Tasmanian Jock Goodyer is the two time defending champion of this weekend's race.
